Concealed Weapons Policy

*Adopted by Board of Trustees
June 13, 2013*



The use, possession or carrying, concealed or unconcealed, of weapons of any type including but not limited to firearms, blowguns, air guns, pellet guns, bows or crossbows, knives that are illegal under Arkansas law, martial arts training materials, slingshots, paintball guns, explosive or incendiary devices, dangerous chemicals, and ammunition are prohibited on university property. An exception is made for residence hall and university apartment residents with hunting equipment. Such equipment must be registered and deposited immediately with the Campus Safety office, which will act as custodian.

This policy applies to all faculty, staff, students, vendors, visitors and any other persons entering any facilities on campus. Campus includes all buildings and property owned or leased by Ouachita Baptist University or its related entities. Exceptions to this policy will be permitted only for qualified law enforcement officers.

An employee or student found to be in violation of this policy will be ordered to remove the weapon from campus immediately and will be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employment or suspension from the university.
